

## Minutes LRMTA Meeting, Monday June 6th, 2005

Christine Rogers brought the meeting/social to order at her home. There were 5 members present. She welcomed Evan Schaaf, graduating student from the U of L.

Linda Dickey moved the acceptance of the agenda. Seconded by Alma Davies. Carried.

Alma Davies moved that the minutes of our May meeting be accepted as circulated. Andrew Gierulski seconded. Carried.

Corrie gave the Treasurer's report. The chequing account balance is \$429.07 and the scholarship account is \$2872.70. Corrie moved the acceptance of the treasurer's report. Linda Dickey seconded.

Andrew reported that the Family Concerts Association had a successful year.

Christine reported that though the Dale Wheeler workshop was not well attended, those that participated found it very informing and interesting. Christine has done up a report that Linda has submitted to Music Theory Network and Corrie and Linda have taken care of completing financial arrangements.

Christine read a draft letter prepared by Lorrie to send to the City in reply to recent correspondence advising us that the City will not be revisiting the license issue in the near future. It was agreed that we should send the letter. Christine will confirm with Lorrie.

Corrie has made arrangements for our branch to contribute \$200 to the CFMTA conference. He has requested that it be used toward workshop and clinic costs, rather than refreshments. The original amount we had anticipated was \$300, but because of our smaller membership and lower bank balance, Corrie has made arrangements for a \$200 contribution.

Unfortunately, the Pop/Duet recital was not well attended. There were 10 original entries but with illness and absences the number of performances was reduced further. It was suggested that we try this recital on a Saturday in the future.

The adult recital was very successful. There were 15 performances including a duet and a trio. A big thank you to Alma Davies, who donated roses for the performers.

The RC workshop presenting new requirements for the Pedagogy Certificate will probably be Saturday, October 15th. Christine will check with Marilyn about booking McKillop.
