Minutes LRMTA Meeting, Monday, March 7th, 2005

They will be talking to Deanna Oye regarding a student from the University performing as a guest artist at our April Recital. A question was raised as to whether or not there might be any performing or masterclass opportunities for our students at the U of L. Christine will follow up on this suggestion.

Our next recital will be held Saturday, April 9th at 2:30 p.m. at Park Meadows Baptist Church on the northside at 2011 – 15th Avenue North – near Safeway and Stan Siwik Pool. Apparently they have a brand new Kawai piano that is very nice. Lorrie Wittke and Joan Milton are convenors.

There is still needed a convenor for the May 15th pop/duet recital at McKillop United Church. If you would be willing, please let Christine know.

Our final adult recital will be June 4th at 10:30 at the Sterndale Bennett. Alma Davies and Christine Rogers have volunteered to be the convenors.

Doreen Laing reported that the Kiwanis Festival is to be held April 11-13. They are on a new computer system and as a result the schedule cards may be a little late in getting to you. Be patient! Marilyn Sinclair passed out the application sheets for the Piano Class Festival. The festival will run May 16th-27th. The deadline for entry is April 15th. Deanna Oye will be the adjudicator. Contact Marilyn for more details. She will be needing volunteer secretaries to help during the sessions, especially in the afternoon. She has one more year before serving for 25 years.
