

## Lethbridge Piano Intensive (ages 7-12 and 13-20)

This summer program is for piano students ages 7+. Students will work with artist-teachers from the University of Lethbridge Department of Music and Conservatory of Music, as well as invited guests in one-on-one lessons, duet, duo or trio coaching, rhythm workshops, master classes, and participate in extra-curricular activities together. In addition, break out sessions will be scheduled on topics such as extended techniques, song-writing, composition, musicians' health and more, and students will be able to practice on-site in the University's excellent facilities. This program will begin with a faculty concert on July 6 and culminate in a final participants' concert open to the public in our beautiful recital hall on July 12. The goal of this program is to provide students of all ages and skill levels an inspiring experience to learn, grow and make lasting friendships with other motivated pianists.

**AGES 7 to 12** (all skill levels welcome) -- COST: \$400
