The goal of the Lethbridge Voice Intensive is to provide an inclusive and supportive environment where students of all vocal backgrounds—classical, musical theatre, or contemporary—can receive comprehensive and intensive vocal training and performance opportunities. The program aims to foster the development of versatile and confident singers by allowing students to express their singing within their preferred styles, and experiment with other styles if they wish. Through a blend of private lessons, ensemble work, specialized workshops, and student concerts/showcases, the program cultivates artistic expression and a sense of community, ensuring all participants can express their voices in their most authentic way.
